The Clementson Trust is a small charity, which benefits those living in the parishes of Lechlade, Eastleach and Southrop. It was set up in the 1930s, using the money from the sale of the District Nurse's house (the house which stands next to the old Memorial Hall).

The trust has a small annual income that it can distribute to those people in the three parishes who are in financial hardship and who are also sick, convalescent, infirm or with disabilities, whether physical or mental. In the past, amongst other things, it has provided telephone extensions, special chairs for the elderly, and other help with medical equipment. It has also helped to pay for visits to hospital and has contributed to home physiotherapy and chiropody. It makes a contribution towards the home nursing provided by Fairford hospital.

The committee feels sure that there may be individuals who would be eligible for help from the fund. They would like to encourage those people in the parishes, who are in financial need and who are in some way ill, or coping either with mental or physical disability, to make themselves known to the Vicar or a member of the committee in absolute confidence, for their request to be considered. The trust is not able to make recurring grants.
